

Ear Cleaning

Ear Health is a visual assessment and can identify ear problems, infections, wax, discharge, signs of parasites and in relevant breeds hair growth. This is checked before a bath to ensure any discharge is noticed before the ears become wet and soapy.



Eyes

Eye Health is a basic visual observation of the eyes, looking for clear, bright eyes with no discharge or excessive tears, Looking for an foreign body in or around the eye and any signs of discomfort. This is done before a bath to enable us to note any discharge or excessive tearing.



What health services do we offer?

Coat and Skin Checks come as standard. Its a quick hand-on assesment to help us work safely with your pet, You can then be alerted if there is anything found.

During this check we look for Mats, Tangles, skin abrasions, cuts and rashes. Lumps and bumps can also be noticed. Hair and thinning patches of the coat can often be linked to medical issues, Parasites and/or stresses.

Again this is not a Veterinary diagnosis and qualified advice is needed. This is done either in the bath or when drying.



Oral Health

Oral care is an importnat part of a groom, It can identify any foreign objects, broken teeth, tartar, lumps etc.

This does not replace veterinary advice and diagnosis but it can help to aid recovery and early diagnosis.

A brief visual inspection is all that is needed and we can then notify the owner at collection if anything unusual is found. We use an Emmi-Pet ultrasonic toothbrush that is silent, painfree and vibration free. it uses microbubbles to clean teeth and gums and helps remove plaque and tartar build up.



5* Health check, Your pets coat, skin, Feet eyes and ears will be checked at each groom. To keep a check on your pets health and well being. This helps to prevent many infections, Illnesses and costly vet bills.
